SUBJECT: Mortgage Sales

PURPOSE This directive defines the process to deal with how to reflect owners of a property

subject to a Mortgage Sale on conversion.

DIRECTIVE

When a Power of Sale has been exercised by a mortgagee and there has been no conveyance registered in the Registry system:

- The Mortgagee, "In Trust" would sign Form 2.
- The Owners on the AFR shall be reflected as:
 - The Mortgagor(s) (Defaulters) enabled by their Deed
 - The Mortgagee, with the qualifier, IN TRUST, enabled by the Mortgage that empowered the sale
- The encumbrancers on the AFR shall also include:
 - The Mortgagee enabled by the Mortgage that empowered the sale

OR

• A written request for exemption, in advance, to the Registrar, may be made to register the "Mortgagee's Deed" in the Registry system, with an undertaking to convert the parcel to Land Titles within 30 days.

Please refer to Real Property Directive 1800 – 001 for required format of the Mortgagee's Deed/Transfer.
